

BRIDGETON TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS
Minutes of Special Meeting
June 14, 2016

The Bridgeton Township Supervisors held a Special Advertised Meeting on June 14, 2016, at the Township Building, 1370 Bridgeton Hill Road, Upper Black Eddy, PA, to discuss the creation of an ad hoc committee for the Comprehensive Plan. Present were Supervisor Roger Keller and Secretary Colleen Pursell.

Chairman Keller called the meeting to order at 5:07 pm.

NEW BUSINESS:

Supervisor Keller led a discussion on the current state of Bridgeton Township and what areas of revision, maintenance or alignment with contemporary life are of importance over the next ten years. The main focus of the ad hoc committee is "brainstorming", at a grass roots level, to gather new thoughts that might otherwise be overlooked in the later investigation. These ideas and others may be used to inform the Township Supervisors and the Planning Commission in the later development of a long range Comprehensive Plan for the Township.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Anne Stimmel, Township Resident, expressed interest in joining the ad hoc committee which is being established by Supervisor Keller. She stated that she enjoys the rural community that Bridgeton Township has to offer. In ten years, Ms. Stimmel sees more visitors and parking at Ringing Rocks along with more residential development. She would like to see zoning issues handled fair but equitable for all residents. A main concern would be for wells and septic systems as expansion in the township continues. This would include water quality. A question was risen as to whether or not the township could add parking near the river for visitors.

Future meetings will be established to continue gathering thoughts and ideas for the Comprehensive Plan.
