

ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE OF BRIDGETON TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, PERTAINING TO THE REGULATION OF PARKING ON
STREETS AND ROAD IN BRIDGETON TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.**

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Bridgeton Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

ARTICLE I. – Purpose

The purpose of this Ordinance is to prohibit parking on either side of Township maintained roads and streets within the boundaries of Bridgeton Township, in order to improve the conditions, set forth herein.

ARTICLE II. – Authority

Pursuant to Section 238 of the Second Class Township Code 53 P.S. 652328, the Board of Supervisors of Bridgeton Township, by ordinance, have the authority to regulate parking and provide penalties for violations of parking restrictions.

ARTICLE III – Findings

The Township has determined that hazardous and unsafe traffic conditions exist within the Township when vehicles are parked on the streets of the Township which is detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township and such impediments interfere with emergency vehicles including fire trucks, ambulances, etc and further interfere with snow removal.

ARTICLE IV – Prohibited Acts

No person shall be permitted to park a motor vehicle, stand or stop a vehicle at any time, on either side of the following streets within the municipal boundary of Bridgeton Township:

1. Berm Lane
2. Birch Road
3. Bridge Lane
4. Boulder Road
5. Canal Lane
6. Firehouse Lane
7. Lodi Hill Road
8. Lonely Cottage Road
9. Old Forge Road

10. Ringing Rocks Road
11. Riverview Circle
12. Singley Road
13. Skyline Drive
14. Woodland Drive.

ARTICLE V – Penalties

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, any person or registered owner of any vehicle who or which violates any provision of this Ordinance, upon conviction, shall be subject to a penalty of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and no more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) plus costs of prosecution and in default of payment thereof, or shall be sentenced to undergo imprisonment on the Bucks County jail for a period not to exceed ten (10) days.

ARTICLE VI – Posting of Signs

Pursuant to the procedures of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, and pursuant to regulations of the Department with respect to signs on highways, Bridgeton Township shall cause to be erected upon the roadways and locations set forth in Article IV hereof, signs regarding the prohibition of parking.

ARTICLE VII – Enforcement

This Ordinance, per the procedure of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation shall be enforceable by Bridgeton Township and such enforcement is assigned to the State Police Barracks in Dublin, Pennsylvania

ARTICLE VIII – Repealer

All other Ordinances and/or Resolutions or parts thereof which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE IX - Savings Clause

That nothing in this Ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any Act or Ordinance hereby repealed; nor shall any just or legal right of remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

ARTICLE X - Severability

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or part

of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Bridgeton Township, that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof had not been included therein.

ARTICLE XI - Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after its enactment.
