

BRIDGETON TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS
Minutes of June 9, 2021 Regular Monthly Meeting

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the regular meeting of the Bridgeton Township Board of Supervisors was held remotely via Zoom on June 9, 2021, as advertised, at the Township Building, 1370 Bridgeton Hill Road, Upper Black Eddy, Pennsylvania. Present were Supervisors Gard Holby, Roger Keller and Michael Lynch. Also present was Secretary / Treasurer Colleen Pursell. Solicitor David Shafkowitz was absent.

Supervisor Holby called the meeting to order at 7:07 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Upon motion by Supervisor Lynch and seconded by Supervisor Holby, which carried 3-0, the minutes from the May 12, 2021, regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors was approved.
