Minutes of May 12, 2021 Regular Monthly Meeting

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the regular meeting of the Bridgeton Township Board of Supervisors was held remotely via Zoom on May 12, 2021, as advertised, at the Township Building, 1370 Bridgeton Hill Road, Upper Black Eddy, Pennsylvania. Present were Supervisors Gard Holby, Roger Keller and Michael Lynch. Also present was Secretary / Treasurer Colleen Pursell. Solicitor David Shafkowitz was absent.
