Minutes of August 11, 2021 Regular Monthly Meeting

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the regular meeting of the Bridgeton Township Board of Supervisors was held remotely via Zoom on August 11, 2021, as advertised, at the Township Building, 1370 Bridgeton Hill Road, Upper Black Eddy, Pennsylvania. Present were Supervisors Gard Holby, Roger Keller. Also present was Secretary / Treasurer Colleen Pursell. Supervisor Michael Lynch and Solicitor David Shafkowitz were absent.
