**Minutes of July 14, 2021 Regular Monthly Meeting**

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the regular meeting of the Bridgeton Township Board of Supervisors was held remotely via Zoom on July 14, 2021, as advertised, at the Township Building, 1370 Bridgeton Hill Road, Upper Black Eddy, Pennsylvania. Present were Supervisors Roger Keller and Michael Lynch. Also present was Secretary / Treasurer Colleen Pursell and Solicitor David Shafkowitz. Supervisor Gard Holby was absent.

3. Supervisor Keller is planning on attending the Milford Borough Council Meeting to discuss truck traffic going over the Milford Bridge into Bridgeton Township.

Supervisor Keller advised that the Board is waiting to hear back from PennDOT regarding their study.

Chris Pursell, Township Resident, expressed concerns regarding zoning issues with his neighbor. Solicitor Shafkowitz advised that this is a civil matter and should be handled by Mr. Pursell's attorney and the court system and/or the police.
