Old Business

1. Local Hydrologic Status update –June 8, 2025

Continuous Monitoring Network (CMN)

1. Skow well logger removal. The pump needs to be pulled. Mary will coordinate when she returns.
2. Gruver East logger replacement. Bill, Riley, and Mary will coordinate when Mary returns. Investigate using the ENO logger from Carrie's well at either location. Will need an electric source within 55 ft. and homeowner permission. Replace Carrie's well with a Global Water unit(?)...will we gain any useful information?

Static Water Level Network (SWL)

1. T. Eckhoff completed Spring ping for M. Lennon, 6/04-05/2025. Mr. Kanak (226 Cafferty Rd. passed away. Tom spoke with his son-in-law, and they are selling the property. BNTGMC should follow this and approach new owners to continue well logging activity. 1916 Ringing Rocks Rd has a new owner, Florie Nebiol (347-668-3847). Tom spoke with her daughter, and they have lived there for 8 years. She is willing to continue

the well logging activity.

2. Dr. Baehr updated Spring synoptics for Tinicum and Bridgeton wells. Groundwater levels are at or above the Spring median level for 9 of the 11 SWL locations. USGS monitored wells are still rising.

 1. Nockamixon Comprehensive Plan water resources discussion on June 3, 2025, cancelled. Meeting rescheduled for July 1, 2025. Tom and Steven will review and attend the meeting
- Tinicum
 1. T. Eckhoff attended the Tinicum Board of Supervisors meeting on June 3, 2025, to discuss the groundwater ordinance and requested BoS to consider tasking PC to review the Nockamixon Groundwater Management Ordinance for adoption. Judith Danko, Township Manager, requested a line-item comparison of Tinicum and Nockamixon groundwater ordinances. Tom responded that documentation was previously submitted to the PC and BoS. Tom has resent the information to Judith Danko. A 'line-by-line' comparison is not a productive effort, and Tom will follow up with Judith Danko on what is needed.
- Bridgeton
 1. The groundwater ordinance is still pending. Karl will attend the Planning Committee meeting tomorrow night.
